



email Addresses – Why we ask for them and What we do with them.

When you register for any TBAYS team or activity, we always ask for an email address. We want to assure you that we do not share this address with anyone else. We don't even send it on the Michigan State Youth Soccer Association, although they ask for it. We respect your privacy and understand your concerns about junk mail in your inbox.

What we DO do with your address is communicate. This is how your coach will probably contact you regarding practices, games, and meetings. This is definitely how TBAYS will contact you with information regarding camps, new offerings, news about board decisions and upcoming elections, etc. We try to make certain that the only information we send to your inbox is relevant to your players. We don't send information about girl's camps to boys or select team tryouts to juniors players.

If you request to have TBAYS remove your address from our mailing list, we will of course comply but you will no longer receive information about the opening and closing dates for registration or other news you may need. For this reason, we really hope that you will be able to provide us with a reliable email address and let us keep you on our mailing list.

For budgetary reasons, TBAYS no longer sends newsletters, election ballots, or registration reminders by regular mail. If you don't have access to email or the website, you should plan to call or visit the office periodically to get information about deadlines and upcoming events or make arrangements to have a friend keep you informed.
